Nine ocean paddling enthusiasts on 3 separate trips will get the chance to experience a *trip of a lifetime* along the majestic Kimberly coastline.

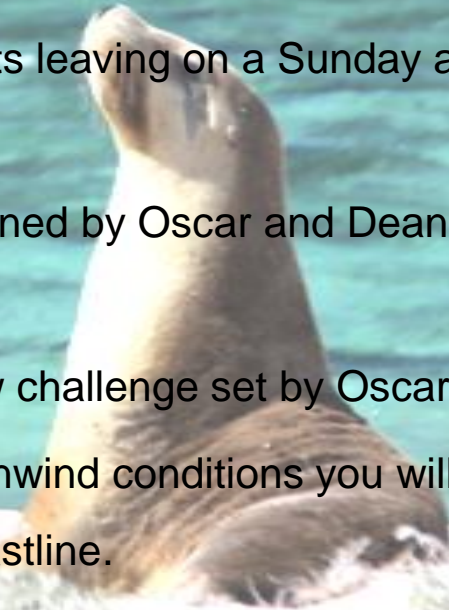

Along the way while taking in the sights, you will be trained by Oscar and Dean and learn the secrets of downwind mastery.


Everyday you will wake up in a new location with a new challenge set by Oscar and Dean.
